Reading: We will be finishing our first reading unit, Second Grade Growth Spurt this week. We will be focusing on what intentions authors have to write books and what the author wants to teach us

Math: Problem solving is a huge component of second grade math. We'll be continue to work through sets of story problem lessons this week. Please continue to practice the addition and subtraction facts at home. Children that have a firm grasp on the basic facts tend to navigate the story problems easier.

Writing: We will continue to work on personal narratives. We'll focus on adding transition words, using dialogue, adding more "juicy" details (by showing, not telling) and revising our writing.

Social Studies: We'll continue to to learn about maps.
