#### A Peek at Our Week

**Reading:** We have completed our first reading unit, Second Grade Growth Spurt. We will spend this week reviewing/learning about the 5 steps of a good retell. Students should include the characters, setting, events, problem and solution. We will also learn a new way to summarize a story by using the strategy Somebody, Wanted, But, So, Then.

Math: We'll end our first math unit focusing on two step word problems. Our first unit test will be this Friday. A study guide went home this past week. Feel free to use it to help your child study. You do not need to return it back to school. Our math test will be set up exactly the way the study guide is set up. Please also continue to practice the addition and subtraction facts at home. Children that have a firm grasp on the basic facts tend to navigate the story problems easier.

Writing: We'll continue our personal narratives. We'll working on showing, not telling (using more specific words and dialogue to help our readers picture out stories), we'll chose the story we want to publish into a final copy and begin editing the piece. We will then begin writing our final copies.

Social Studies: We'll finish up our unit on maps.

**7- Habits-** We will focus on the third habit, Put first Things first- Work hard THEN play! This means I'll say no to things that I will say no to things that I should not do, I am disciplined and organized, I spend my time on things that are most important, I set priorities, set a schedule and make a plan.
