A Peek at Our Week

Reading: We will continue spend this week reviewing about the 5 steps of a good retell. Students should include the characters, setting, events, problem and solution. We will also continue to summarize a stories by using the strategy Somebody, Wanted, But, So, Then.

Math: We wrapped up our first math unit with the chapter test. We'll spend the next week reviewing place value and comparing numbers. The main focus of our next unit is adding two digit numbers, including regrouping, also known as carrying. Please continue to practice the addition and subtraction facts at home. Students that are fluent with their math facts transition easily to double digit addition. It is often more difficult for students that don't know their facts.

Writing: We'll work on writing our final copies of our personal narratives.

Science: We'll begin our unit on matter. This week we'll work on learning what science is, what a scientist does, and how scientists get their ideas.

7- Habits- We will focus on the fourth habit, Think Win-Win. We'll learn that when conflict arises, I'll look for a third alternative, I make deposits in other' emotional bank accounts and I balance courage for getting what I want with consideration for what others want. Everyone can win!
